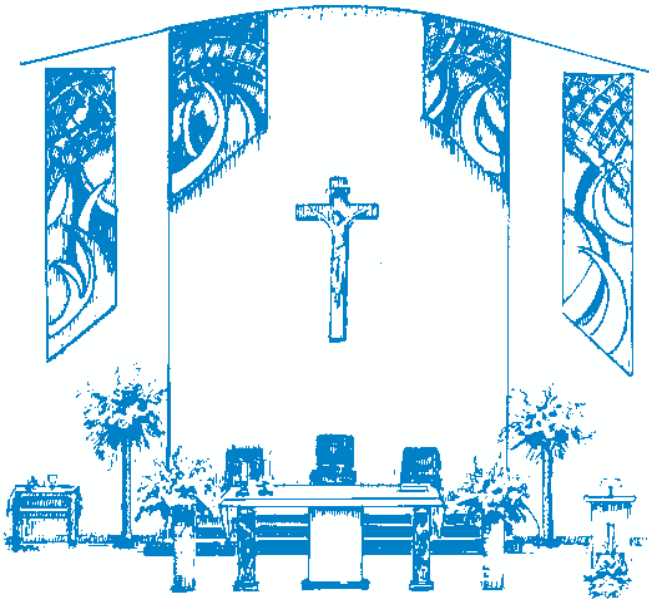

“YES” TO THE KING

The Church crowns the year of grace, its liturgical year, with the solemnity of Christ the King. We could assume that a celebration of this magnitude would provide us with an easy, clear presentation of who Christ is and who he calls us to be. But this feast flings the paradoxes of Christ’s kingship in our face. Is Christ all-powerful? Is he the Messiah, the Anointed of God? Is he a victim, powerless in the hands of mortal rulers? Is he dead on the cross? Is he alive in the splendor of eternal light? Is the inscription above his head true? Is he Shepherd or slaughtered lamb? The answer is “Yes.”

What may be even more difficult is that we have also answered “Yes” to following this complex, paradoxical King who reigns from the cross of death, who upsets our expectations and challenges us to upset many of the expectations of the world around us. But before we despair of being able to sustain the difficulty of this mission, we are also strengthened by Paul’s words to the Colossians. We are reminded that if we keep our eyes fixed on the cross, the throne of Christ, we will also find and know the source of our reconciliation, our peace, and our hope to join him, sharing the inheritance of the holy ones in light everlasting.

EL SEÑOR NOS FORTALECE

Si pasas por un club de gimnasia temprano por la mañana, usualmente verás a un buen número de automóviles estacionados afuera. Puede que veas más vehículos estacionados allí que en la parroquia para la misa de la mañana o la oración de la mañana. Cuando el apóstol Pablo habla hoy de que la palabra del Señor “se propague con rapidez” (2 Tesalonicenses 3:1) hace una alusión a las carreras atléticas. Este tipo de referencia es una de las más frecuentes en sus cartas. En este mundo influenciado por la cultura griega, el gimnasio de la ciudad era el lugar para el atletismo, y también para la poesía, la filosofía y las discusiones políticas. Era un lugar para el cuerpo, la mente y el espíritu

Todos los aspectos de nuestra vida deben ser guiados por la palabra del Señor. Podemos hacer ejercicio en el club atlético para tener un cuerpo en forma, pero al final será el Señor quien nos fortalecerá. De igual manera, será la propia fortaleza del Señor que debemos emplear en nuestra vocación de discípulos: para propagar la palabra del Señor, para que Cristo sea conocido y Dios glorificado por nuestro testimonio. San Pablo lo resume todo diciéndonos cómo será el corazón del discípulo: dirigido en todo momento hacia el amor de Dios, y esperando pacientemente a Cristo.
